

# Dependent Coverage Notice

A group health plan and a health insurance issuer offering group or individual health insurance coverage that provides dependent coverage of children shall continue to make such coverage available for an adult child until the child turns 26 years of age.

**Individuals whose coverage ended, or who were denied coverage (or were not eligible for coverage), because the availability of dependent coverage of children ended before attainment of age 26 are eligible to enroll in the group health plan or health insurance coverage. Individuals may request enrollment for such children during the normal 30 day enrollment period.**

**To be eligible to enroll as a Dependent child, a person must be a child of the Subscriber, provided that the following conditions are met:**

- The child is under the age of 26; and
- The natural child or stepchild of the Subscriber; or
- A legally adopted child in the custody of the Subscriber from the time of placement in the home (written evidence of adoption must be furnished to AvMed upon request); or
- A child for whom the Subscriber has been appointed legal guardian pursuant to a valid court order.
